The peanut butter will provide a large supply of shelf-stable protein. Our Food Pantry has experienced over 11,000 visits this year, serving about 250 people per week. Studies show that 9% of Muscatine County residents are food insecure, and this includes 1,700 children. With our incredible community, we are able to assist those who face barriers with regular access to enough food for a healthy lifestyle.

We challenged Muscatine to collect jelly to match the generous donation from Hy-Vee, and two sophomores at Muscatine High School rose to the occasion. Abbie & Emma Yerington used funds from their Coins for Christmas fundraiser to purchase 1,000 pounds of jelly to donate to our Food Pantry. Domestic Violence Awareness Month

October is Domestic Violence Awareness Month, and this month we spent much of our time visiting local schools, painting pinkies purple, posting facts and statistics about domestic violence, and more. Research shows that on average, almost 20 people per minute fall victim to intimate partner violence. Additionally, on average, over 20,000 calls per day are made to domestic violence hotlines across the United States.

The MCSA Domestic Violence Shelter is here to help. Our shelter is the only shelter in Muscatine County, is staffed 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, and offers free and confidential services to those in need. Assistance with housing and job options, food, clothing, and basic needs is available. In 2018, the shelter served 70 individuals, including over 30 children.
